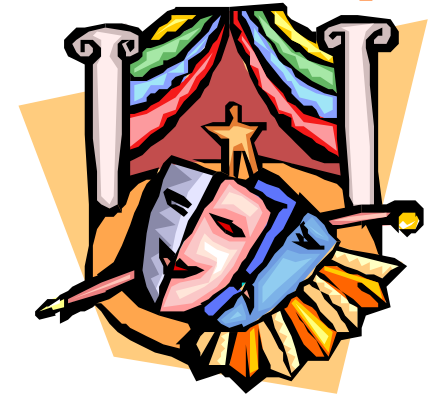

## What is Body & Mind Theater Camp?

Campers will be exposed to several elements of theater to help them produce a full stage show. Theater games and improvisational techniques will assist in character development. Auditioning, singing and basic dance styles will be incorporated into the camp experience.

Campers will learn about costumes and set design and be challenged to help design and build these elements.

Also, campers will have the opportunity to swim each day. The open swim time is a great time for them to relax with their friends!

### Early Drop Off/Late Pickup:

Early drop off and late pickup are available for those parents who require it. Children can be dropped off at 9:00am and picked up by 5:00pm. During these additional hours kids will be supervised in The Yard, Health Unlimited's interactive play area. The daily fee for early drop off and late pickup is \$3 for members and \$6 for nonmembers.

For the finale of the camp, the students will premier *Birds of a Feather*. During this musical, children will showcase all that they have learned throughout the camp. The show is free so bring the entire family to show your support.
